



## Orée des Cîmes Stole

Yarn: 150 g of Baby Alpaga (4 ply) in « Linen »  
(approx. 550 meters/600 yards – yarn held  
doubled throughout)

Needles: 7 mm (US 10 ½ )

Gauge: 13 st x 14 rows = 10 cm/4 in in pattern

Wooden pin to close the stole.

Note:

SKP: Slip one, knit one, pass slip stitch over  
yo: yarn over

Holding yarn doubled, cast on 50 st. Work as follows:

Rows 1-4: Slip first st (selvage st), knit to end of row.

Row 5: Slip first st, \*SKP, K7, yo, K3\*; repeat from \* to \* to last st, K1.

Row 6: Slip first st, purl to end of row.

Repeat rows 5 and 6 for desired length (make sure there is enough yarn left for the last four rows and the bind off).

Rows 7-10 : Slip first st, knit to end of row.

Bind off all stitches.

Weave in ends and steam block at a low temperature setting.
